Schedule of Fees for Equestrian Services, 2009

Effective from Term 1, 2009 (All amounts include GST and are expressed in NZ\$)

Stabling Fees

Full year - \$1300 per pupil (\$32.50 per week)

Two terms - \$900 per pupil (\$45 per week)

- Every week there after \$45 per week

One term - \$500 per pupil (\$50 per week)

- Every week there after \$50 per week

Week by week - \$80 per pupil per week (\$80 per week)

You are free to select your preference from the four payment options

Additional Fee's

Individual paddocks - \$20 per week (this is on top of your elected grazing option)

School ponies - \$600 per pupil per term

School Truck - \$2.20 per km divided by the number of horses travelling on the truck.

Day girls who compete for the school - \$100 per pupil per year.

Rebates

A family with two or more girls, both with ponies/horses at the school – 10% discount

A pupil with two ponies/horses at school – 40% discount on the second pony/horse.

Notes

- I. The individual paddocks will become the responsibility of the pupil to keep clean etc and will be mucked out daily
- II. The individual paddocks cost \$20 per paddock, (plus your grazing option) so if the owner wants to share with someone else and put two horses in the paddock, then it would be \$10 each.
- III. It is intended that the individual paddocks will be allocated for the full year option first, followed by the two term option, and then the one term option.
- IV. If a pupil has paid for a full year, two terms, or one term option and the horse becomes injured, then a refund will be given upon the receipt of a vet certificate.
