### Boards at Nga Tawa

As a state integrated school, Nga Tawa has two boards of trustees, Nga Tawa Diocesan School Trust Board (Proprietor) and Nga Tawa Diocesan School Board of Trustees (Elected Governance Board, BOT).

### Invoicing of Fees

All fees, voluntary contributions and donations are invoiced by the Diocesan Trust Board (Proprietor).

Donations are voluntary contributions; they are only included on invoices as a form of request. The General Contribution is collected by the Proprietor and passed to the Board of Trustees to support the curriculum and staffing.

### Attendance Dues

Attendance Dues are a compulsory fee that must be paid by all students attending Nga Tawa, (Day Students and Boarding). Attendance Dues are administered by the Proprietors Board and provide for property and compliance costs for the integrated school buildings.

### Insurance (Fee Protection)

The Trust Board underwrites an Insurance Policy that covers the Boarding Fees for the remainder of the student's time at Nga Tawa should the death of the (fee payer) parent or caregiver take place. This covers parents and caregiver up to the age of 65 and does not cover death for a pre-existing condition prior to the student accepting a place at Nga Tawa.

## Voluntary Donations

Donations are requested to fund additional resources for the breadth of the curricular and co-curricular activities at Nga Tawa. These donations also assist with ongoing building, works and the delivery of the special character. All Donations are exempt of GST and a receipt will be issued for donations paid on an annual basis.

## Other Annual Charges – Charged on your January invoice

Administration Fee	\$100 (boarders only)
PFA Donation	\$60 (per family) voluntary
Medical Admin Fee	\$65 (Boarders)
House Subs	\$30 (All students) voluntary
Internet Charge	\$150 (Boarders)
Old Girls Membership	\$250 charged at the end of the first term to all new students.

## How fees are charged

The annual School Fees are charged out over a ten-month period. The first invoice will be dated 31 January 2024, due for payment 20 February 2024. The last fee invoice for the 2024 year is dated 31 October, due for payment 20 November 2024.
