

## **NGA TAWA SCHOOL PONY**

The Equestrian Academy makes available a number of horses and ponies each year for the use of new riders. This would involve your daughter learning to care for the animal, receiving riding lessons and being involved in Equestrian activities. The horse will have a bridle and saddle and all necessary equipment, including brushes and cover. Each student will learn how to care for the pony and this expensive equipment as part of the requirements of the course.

Your daughter will need to supply her own riding clothing, including crash hat, jodhpurs and riding boots, as well as gumboots and waterproof raincoat.

The cost of the horse will cover the cost of grazing, feeding, shoeing and any vet's bills that might be incurred. Please select one of the following options:

0	School Pony Beginner	A student who has never ridden or limited experience, in riding and maintaining a horse or pony.
0	School Pony Experienced	A student with some experience in riding and horse maintenance or has graduated from the beginner programme.
0	School Pony Advanced	A student who is a highly competitive rider.
