- A covering letter
- A completed scholarship checklist form
- Latest school report
- CAA (Common Assessment Activities) results
- Nga Tawa Diocesan School application form

Your daughter's covering letter should succinctly describe her interests, activities, and achievements. In this, we require information about co-curricular involvement, previous achievements, academic outcomes, and any leadership roles she has held at her current school.

- Applicants must have completed an application form for Nga Tawa Diocesan School
- Only new students in 2026 are eligible for this scholarship
- Pre-enrolled weekly or full boarder
- Recipients must display our values of Respect, Integrity and Courage at all times
- The recipient must make herself available to all Nga Tawa Diocesan School matches and practices in her chosen sport
- The decision of an applicant's success is the prerogative of the school
- Scholarships are subject to a termly review in sport/performing arts as well as academic outcomes

- Shortlisted students will be required to attend an interview with the Principal at Nga Tawa Diocesan School.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in **Term 4**.
